Please complete all forms at home they will be sent to you by e mail or text 3-4 days before your appointment. You do not need to print them off they are saved to a portal that we can access. This will minimise the contact you have with un-necessary objects in the practice.

If you have been travelling internationally within the last 14 days please call the practice before attending.

If you have been contacted by Test and Trace and been told to isolate please call the practice to let us know.

If you feel unwell prior to your appointment or you are concerned you are exhibiting any signs of Covid-19 please call the practice, we can re-schedule your appointment.

Our ultimate aim is to keep you safe, if you are vulnerable or shielding, please inform a member of the team, we can arrange appointment times at the beginning of each session, to ensure you are the first one in surgery.

Please come alone if possible, and ensure you are wearing a face covering.

On arrival at the practice the reception door will be locked. Use the hand-gel in

the porch, check the questionnaire in the porch, once you are happy you are able to enter the building press the buzzer. Once you are allowed in the building our staff may take your temperature.

Clean your teeth before you arrive, we are trying not to use the rest room facilities. If you do need to use them tell a member of our team.

Keep belongings to an absolute minimum, we have boxes to place personal possessions in.

We do encourage contactless payments where possible.

Hand gel stations are positioned around the building, there is a separate entrance and exit.

All team members are happy to help with any questions you may have.

We aim to do our best to keep you safe during the pandemic, if you have concerns or queries, please speak to a member of the team, who will help you or pass on your query to an appropriate person.
